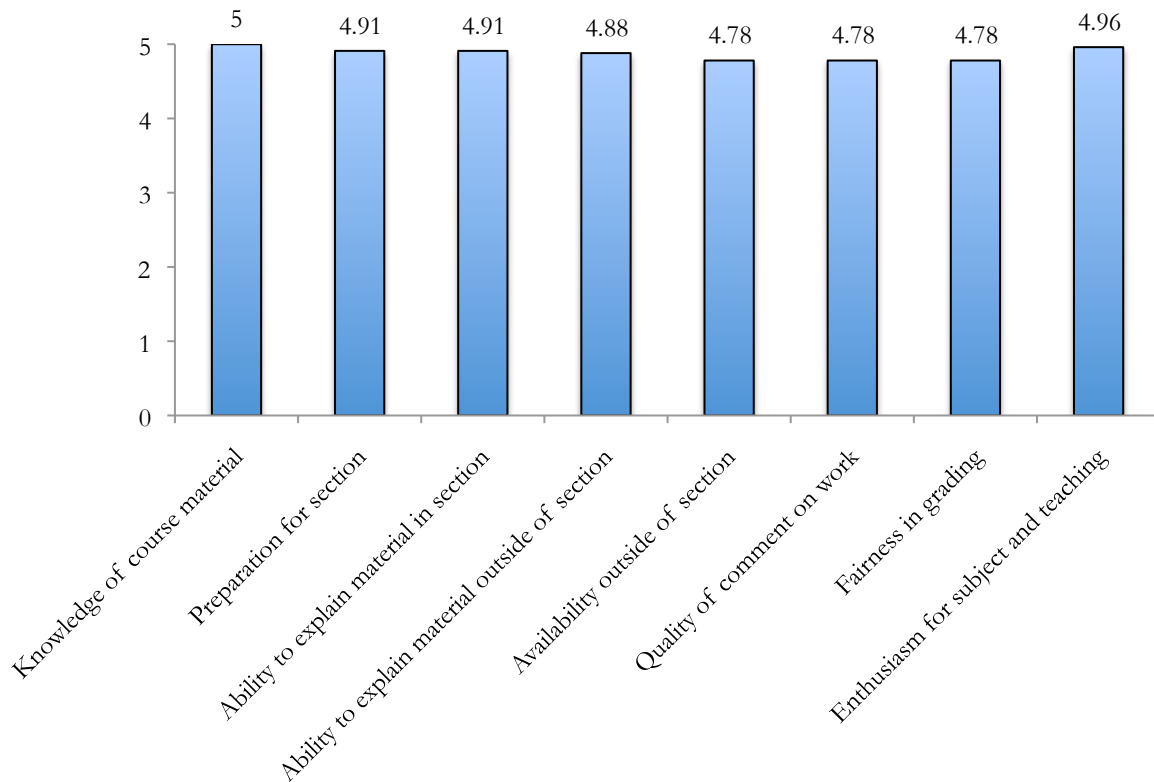


## Introduction to Greek Philosophy Fall 2017
